What are we looking for?

- Location: Within or near the local community, with accessible transport links (buses, trains, etc).
- Building Size: Approximately 400m² (4,000 sqft), accessible for wheelchairs, with large open rooms, a kitchen or space for one
- Outside Space: Outdoor space for activities
