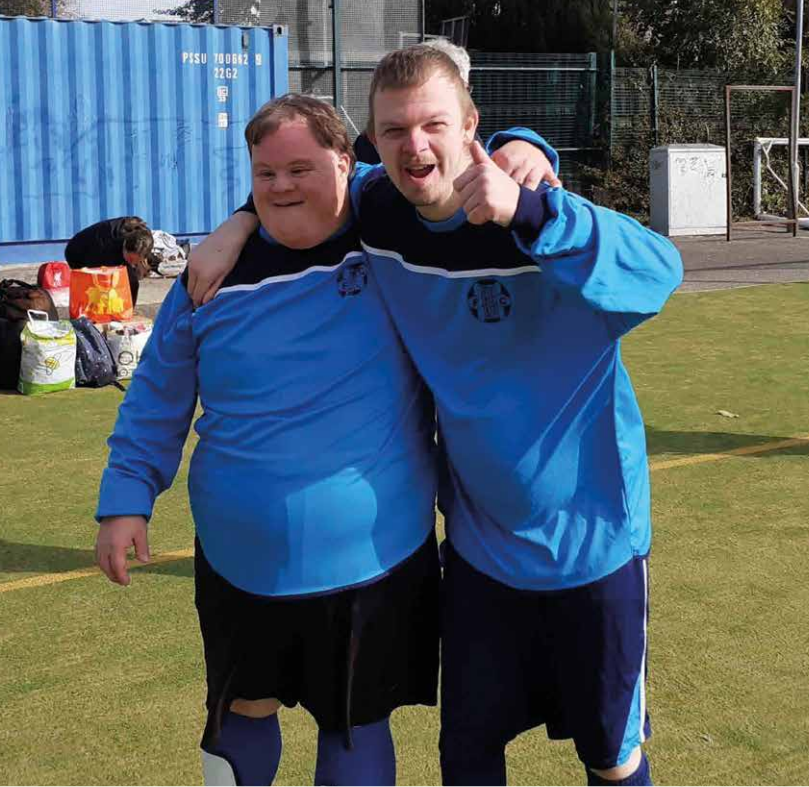

Papworth Trust has delivered vital housing, employment, care, employment, training and leisure services for disabled people in the East of England since 1917. Today the Trust has a turnover of £14m, employs around 225 staff (FTE) and operates across Cambridgeshire, Essex and Suffolk, with some additional housing in the surrounding areas.





Our 673 homes across the East of England enable people to live as independently as possible. 75% are for supported living. In addition, a third (33%) of our homes are fully wheelchair accessible with a further 19% are classified as 'accessible'. Working alongside partners including Local Authorities and other Housing Associations, we are passionate about finding housing solutions to meet the needs of disabled people.

Employment



We're very proud of our extensive heritage of supporting disabled and disadvantaged people to find work. The Trust delivers the WorkWell Programme in Partnership with Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Integrated Care System (ICS) and the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP). We also provide our own bespoke employment programme called Routeways to Work.



We deliver compassionate, professional care tailored to the needs of customers and their families while also promoting independence and social inclusion. Our specialism is supporting people with complex needs, often when they've transitioned from secure settings. We have care services across Suffolk and are proud that all of our services are rated by CQC as either Good or Outstanding.

Day Opportunities



The Trust's Day Opportunities exist to ensure that disabled people can acquire independent living skills, live healthy lives and reduce social isolation. Our service is delivered from five centres (in Basildon, Cambridge, Huntingdon, Ipswich and Sawston) with people being able to access sessions in the community as well as at a centre. We are constantly adapting to the world around us and the needs of our customers. This drives a blended model to support our customers reaching their potential.



OWL Bikes offers quality refurbished bikes at great prices - while offering work and training opportunities for local disabled people.

Routeways to Work is a project that combines work experience in our commercial bicycle shop and workshop, with employment support and guidance.

The shop, based in Cambridge, sells refurbished bikes and accessories to the local community as well as carrying out repairs.
