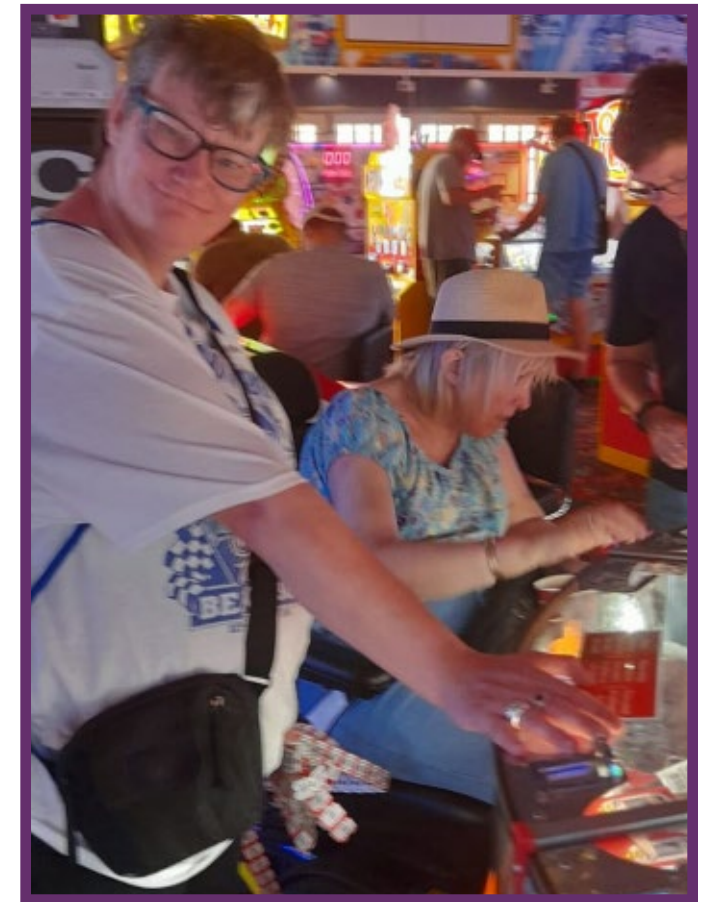

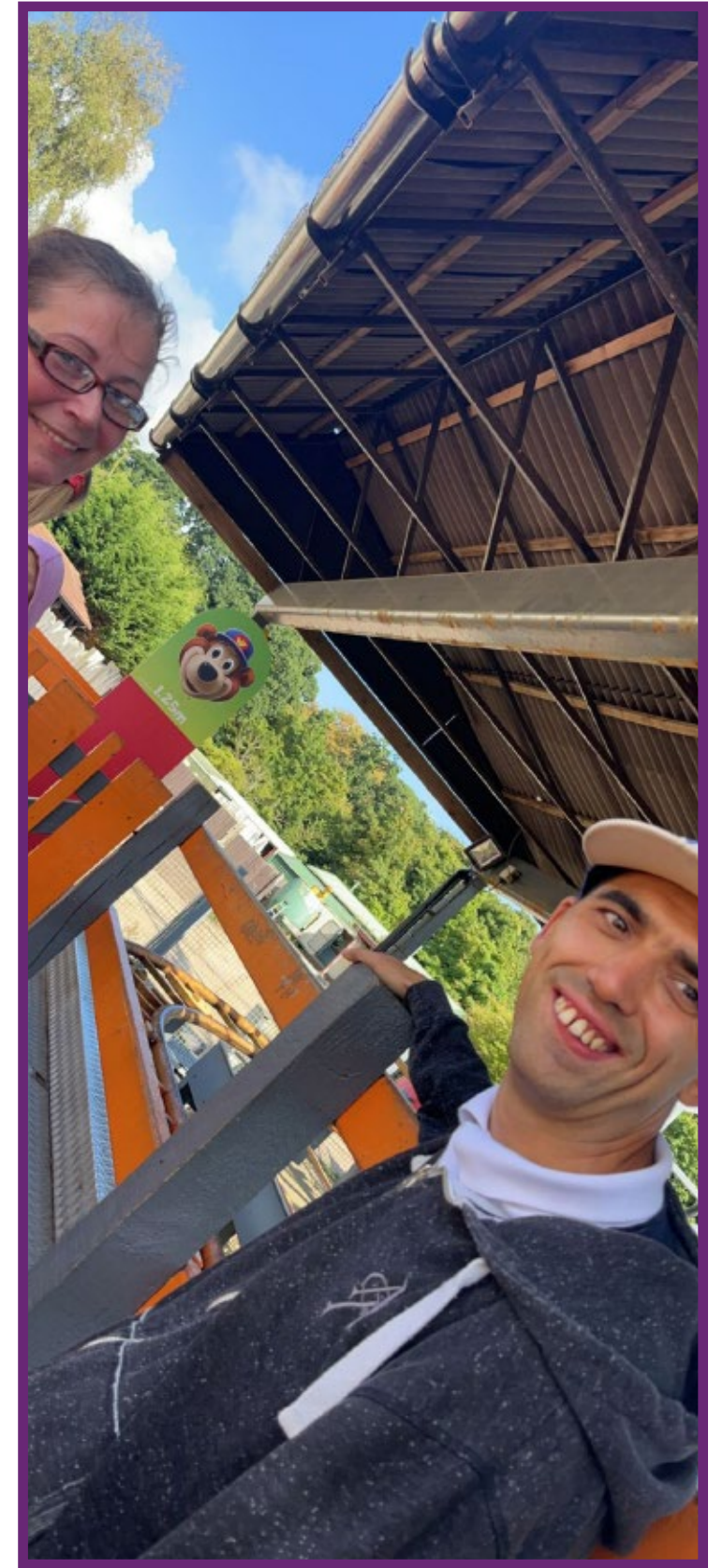
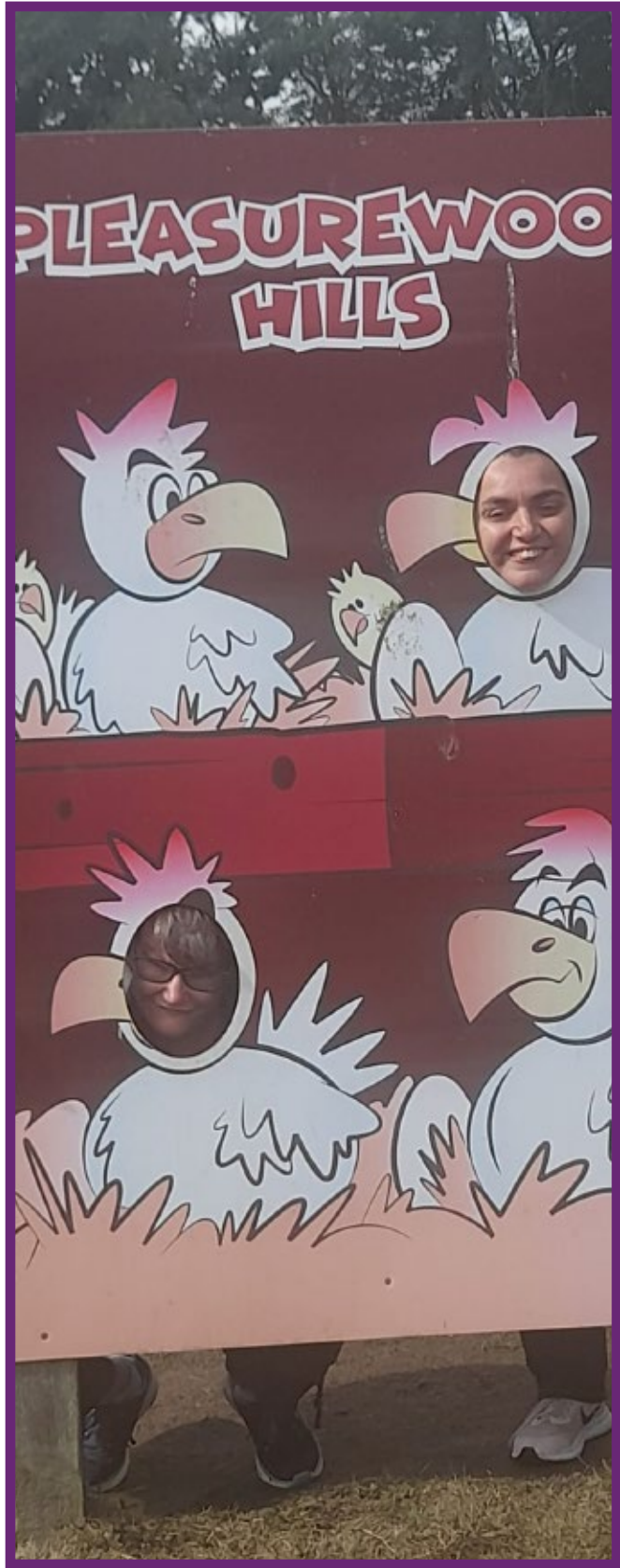


Pleasurewood Hills
