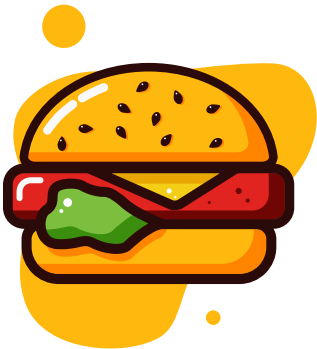
# Happy Birthday Linda!

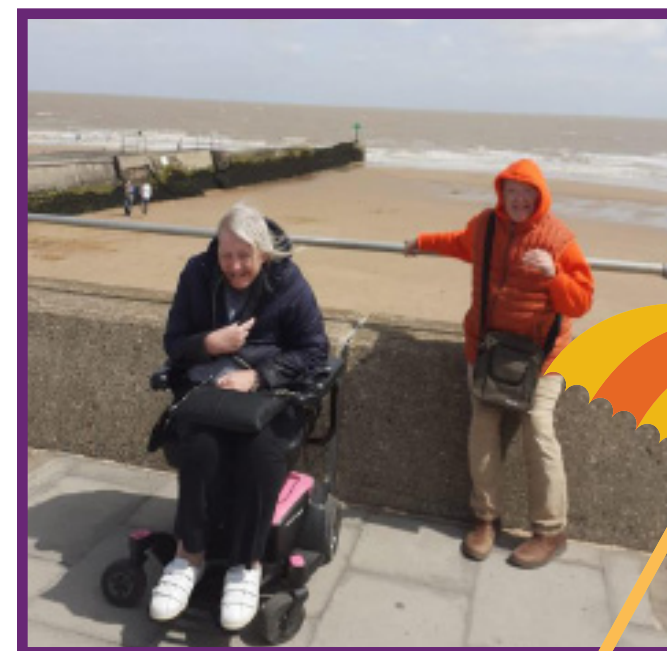
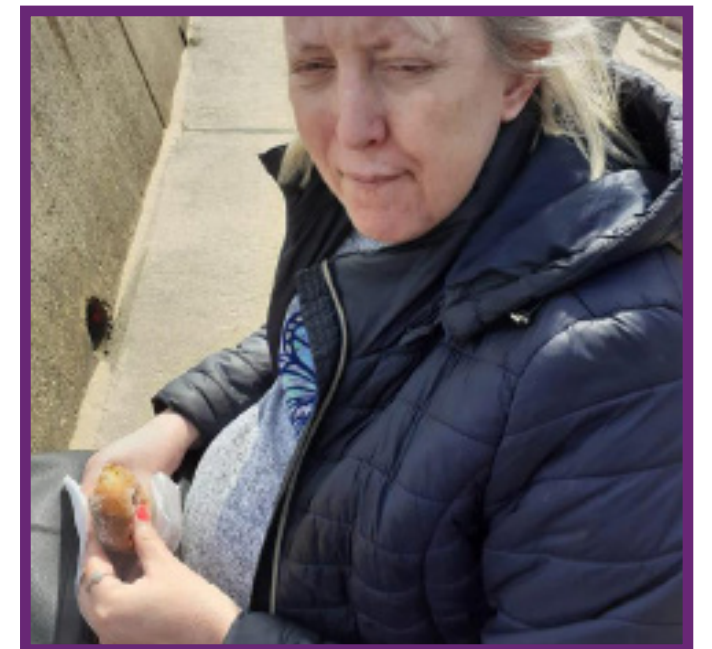
## Furry friends

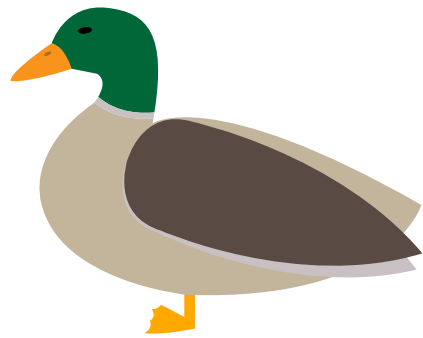
# Happy Birthday Emma

# A trip to Scottsdale's

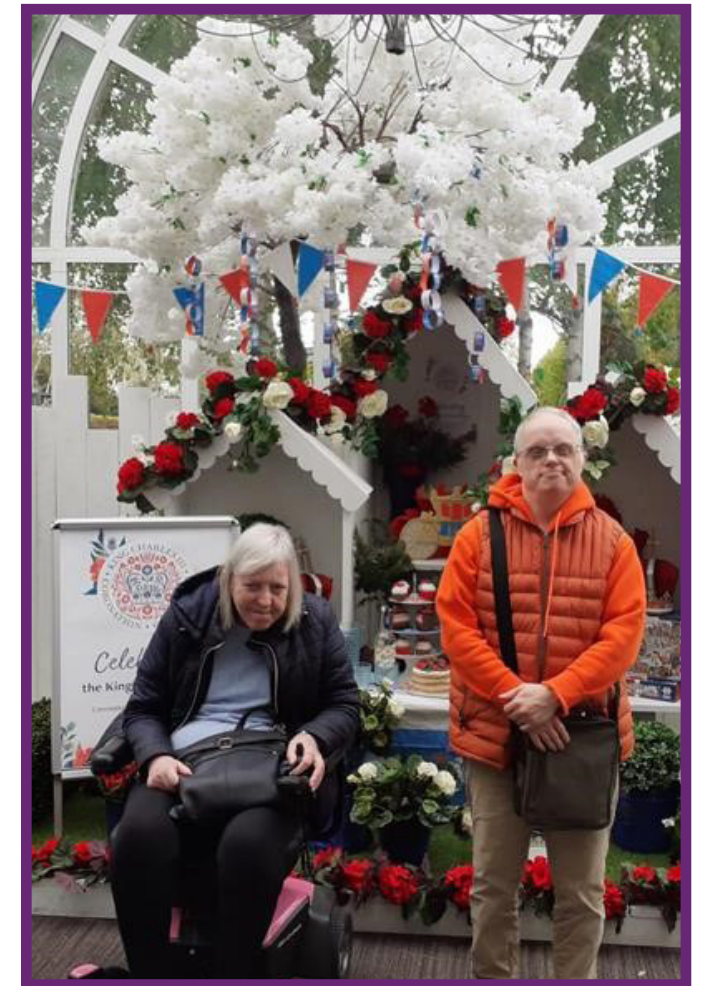

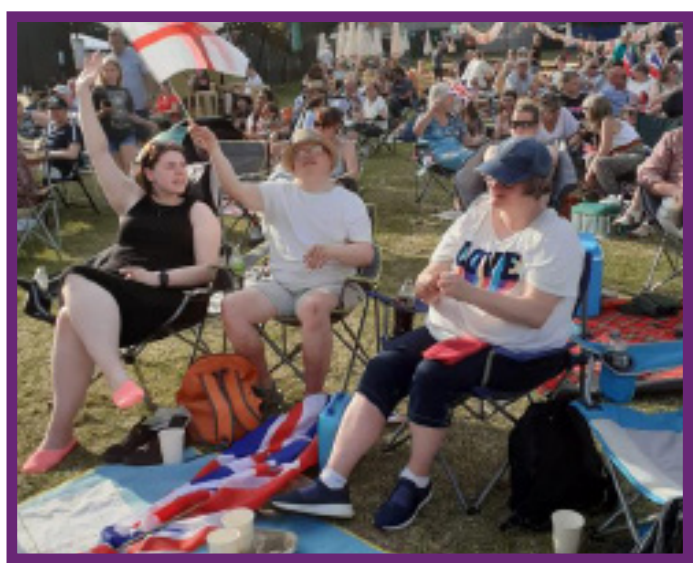
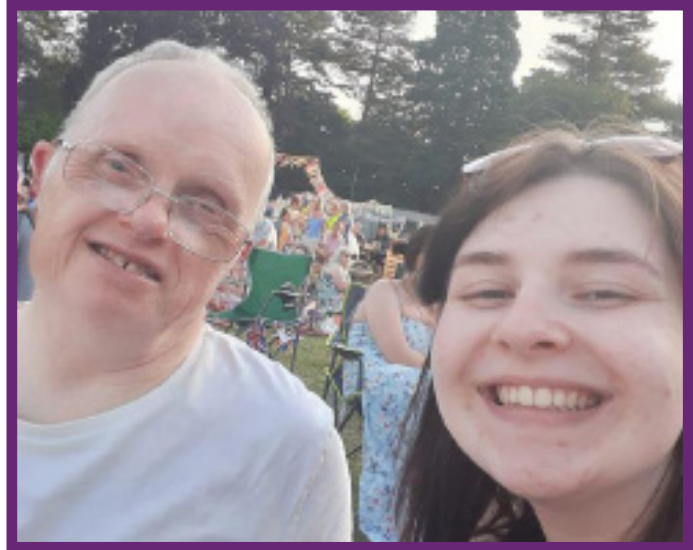
# Emma's Holiday
