Eating out

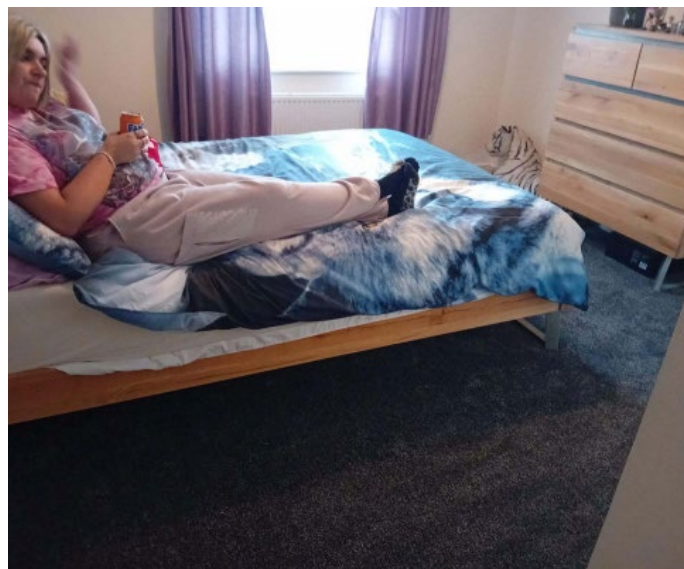
