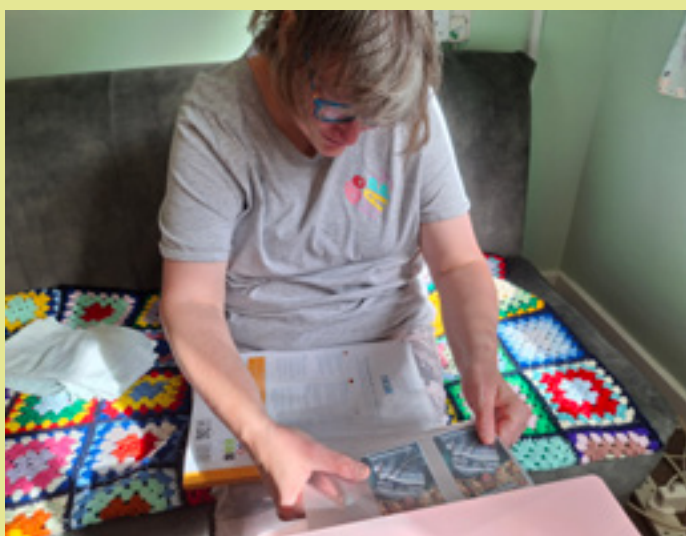
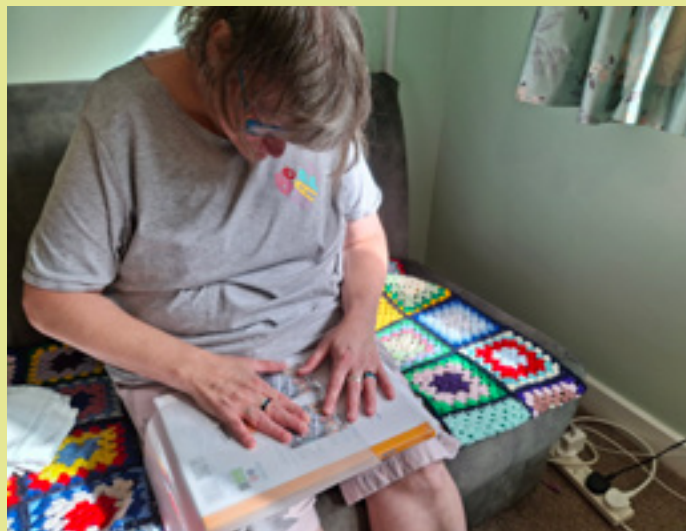
Clare Country Park
