Adrian scoops an award


A volunteer at our centre, Adrian Swinchatt, has won the 'Inspirational Role Model' award at the 2023 Basildon Borough Volunteer Awards.






Out and about

Customers have been out and about lately. Some customers participated in a bird watching exercise and others have been volunteering at Barleylands Farm.















Out and about

Cooking Sessions


During their cooking sessions, customers have been making lots of yummy foods. They made a lovely cottage pie, great comfort food to keep them warm during the cold weather.
