Introduction

This Cookies Notice explains how Papworth Trust uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit our website:

This notice should be read alongside our Website Privacy Notice.

Papworth Trust uses cookies in accordance with UK GDPR, the Data Protection Act 2018, the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR), and the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, remember choices, improve performance and understand how visitors use the site.

Some cookies are essential. Others are optional and will only be used where you have given consent.

Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are required for the website to work. They support security, accessibility, page navigation, form submission and cookie preference management.

These cookies do not require consent.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website, such as which pages are visited and how people move around the site.

These cookies are only used where you have given consent.

Functional Cookies

Functional cookies help remember choices you make, such as accessibility settings, preferences or enhanced website features.

All non-essential functional cookies require your opt-in consent.

Where a functional cookie is strictly necessary to provide a service you have specifically requested, it will be treated as a strictly necessary cookie.

Marketing, Social Media and Embedded Content Cookies

These cookies may be used by third-party platforms to support embedded content, fundraising campaigns, social media sharing or advertising measurement.

These cookies are only used where you have given consent.

6. Cookie Consent and Preference Centre

When you first visit our website, you will be shown a cookie banner allowing you to:

- Accept all cookies;
- Reject non-essential cookies;
- Manage your cookie preferences.

You can change or withdraw your consent at any time by clicking the **cookie settings icon** on our website or by selecting “**Manage Cookie Preferences**” in the website footer.

Non-essential cookies will not be placed on your device unless you have given consent.

Managing Cookies Through Your Browser

You can also manage cookies through your browser settings. Most browsers allow you to block, delete or restrict cookies.

Please note that blocking strictly necessary cookies may affect how the website works.

Information Collected Through Cookies

Cookies may collect:

- IP address;

- Device information;
- Browser type;
- Operating system;
- Pages visited;
- Date and time of visits;
- Referring website;
- Cookie identifiers;
- Website usage information.

Where this information identifies you, it will be handled in accordance with our Website Privacy Notice.

International Transfers

Some third-party cookie providers may process information outside the United Kingdom.

Where this occurs, appropriate safeguards will be used, such as UK adequacy regulations, International Data Transfer Agreements, Standard Contractual Clauses or other legally approved safeguards.

How Long Cookies Remain on Your Device

Cookies may be:

- **Session cookies**, which are deleted when you close your browser; or
- **Persistent cookies**, which remain on your device for a set period unless deleted earlier.

The exact lifespan of each cookie is listed in the cookie table above.

Your Rights

Where cookies involve the processing of personal information, you have rights under UK GDPR, including the right to access, correct, restrict, object to or request deletion of your personal information.

You also have the right to withdraw consent for non-essential cookies at any time.
